DIRECTIONS TO KIMBERLY FARMS RIDINGS STABLES

From the South:

From Bennington Area, Take Rte. 7A North. Look for Wm. Daily Concrete on the right. Turn left at the next road (Myers). The farm is 3.5 miles on the right side. You will pass 3 other farms, then go over a hill OR go to Power's Market in North Bennington, travel 2.9 miles on Bank Street, which then turns into White Creek Road. (Be sure to bear right at the No. Bennington Variety Store). Look for our signs on White Creek Road.

From the North:

From Manchester area, Take Historic Ret. 7A South approximately 15 miles. Look for our road sign in Shaftsbury. At the Hillbrook Motel (Myers Road), turn right . The farm is 3.5 miles on the right side (Clock it on your car). You will pass 3 other farms, then go over a hill.
